Employee Discount – Customers who have satisfied the requirements for and are receiving the NWE Employee Discount shall obtain a discount on their bill. The discount shall be an amount equal to 25% of the total propane bill.

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SPECIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

1. Reconnection Charge: If a Customer terminates service and subsequently requests a service reconnect at the same address within 24 months following the discontinuance, the Utility may charge the Customer the monthly fixed charges not paid during the time of termination. Fixed charges can only be recovered from Customers who terminate and renew service at the same address within the subsequent 24-month period, where no other Customer has taken service in the interim at that address. Rates for all tariffs are based on continuing service and collection of monthly fixed charges at each service location.
2. Multiple Residential Dwelling Units: Where the same building complex contains multiple residential dwelling units, each building shall be separately metered. If the building owner requests individual meters for each residential unit within the building(s) and such individual meters are installed, the applicable rates are those set forth above.
3. Definitions: All definitions of the principal terms used in this Rate Schedule are contained in Rule No. 1.
4. Rules: The service under this Rate Schedule is subject to the service rules and regulations specified in the Propane Tariff Rules for the Utility.

SERVICE AND RATES SUBJECT TO COMMISSION JURISDICTION: All rates and service conditions under this Rate Schedule are governed by the rules and regulations of the Public Service Commission of Montana and are subject to revision as the Commission may duly authorize in the exercise of its jurisdiction.
